



Brixhibition Kids Competition 2026

Information and Conditions of Entry for Individual Students

The Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. invites all Primary School Children living in the West Coast or North West Coast, to compete in a LEGO building competition, running in the second term of 2026.

For schools or community groups with less than 12 participating students

All students to enter into the same age group, with only one overall winner's medallion awarded.

For schools or community groups with more than 12 participating students

There are four age groups (with a least 3 students per age group)

- **Kinder -Prep:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 1-2:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 3-4:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 5-6:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)



Your school or community group must pick one overall winner from your age group winners to represent your school this year.

Your school's or community group's overall winner will receive 1x "Age Group & Overall" winner's medallion, plus 1x voucher for a Leven River Cruise, 1x free pass to Beaconsfield Heritage Museum, Richmond Gaol and a free family pass to Brixhibition Hobart 2026.

Each Primary School can determine their own LEGO challenge winner with the following rules and conditions.

- Each LEGO display to be no larger than 52cm x 52cm x 52cm, or no larger than four 32 x 32 lug LEGO baseplates.
- Each LEGO display must be an original design. It must **NOT** be an assembled LEGO set or built from published instructions – (e.g., from a Rebrickable download.)

- Some Adult help is allowed, but the LEGO design should be the child's own design.
- Each School must confirm their participation no later than **Friday 14th August 2026**
- Each LEGO entry to be completed and displayed at your school, in house or virtually, by **Monday 14th September 2026**.
- Each Primary School's overall winner must be determined and announced, by no later than **Friday 21st September 2026**.
- Schools and community groups can choose to undertake their own judging by photos (virtual) or in-house (as per previous years).
- Each Schools or community groups LEGO Challenge overall winner will then compete against other schools or community groups overall winners at Brixhibition Hobart 2026.
- All LEGO Challenge overall winners will be judged by Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. members, to determine the Grand Prize winners by bringing their model to South East Sports Complex, Montag Street, Sorell, to be on display at the Brixhibition Hobart 2026 event **Saturday 10th and Sunday 11th October**
- Grand Prize winners will be announced at 3:20pm on Sunday 11th October during Brixhibition Hobart 2026.
