

Brixhibition Lego Challenge 2022

Information and Conditions of entry for individual Primary School aged students

The Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. invites all Primary Schools and Primary School Children in Southern Tasmania, to compete in a Lego Challenge running in the third term of 2022.

For schools with less than 12 participating students

all students to enter into the same age group, with only one overall winners mediation awarded.

For schools with more than 12 participating students there are 3x age groups (with a least 4 students per age group)

- Judge/s select a winner for each age group and one overall winner for the challenge.
- You will receive 3 medallions, 2 for age group winners, and 1 Medallion for the age group and overall winner combined.



The overall winner will represent your school at Brixhibition to compete with other schools.

All three winners also receive:

- 1x voucher for a Leven River Cruise,
- 1x free pass to Beaconsfield Heritage Museum,
- 1x free pass to Richmond Gaol.

The overall winner will also receive:

- a "Winning Student Entry Form",
- 1x child & 1x Adult Free pass to Brixhibition Hobart 2022.
- They will need to deliver and pick-up their model to Brixhibition Hobart 2022

Each Primary School can determine their own Lego challenge winner with the following rules and conditions.

- Each Lego display to be no larger than 52cm x 52cm x 52cm, or no larger than four 32x32 lug Lego baseplates.
- Each Lego display must be an original or freelance design and not made from a Lego kit.
- Some Adult help is allowed, but the Lego design should mainly be child's own design.
- Each School must confirm their participation no later than **Friday 19**th **August 2022**
- Each Lego entry to be completed and displayed at your school, in house or virtually, by no later than **Monday 12**th **September 2022.**
- Each Primary School's overall winner must be determined and announced by no later than Friday 16th September 2022.
- Individual participating Schools can choose to undertake their own judging in-house (as previous years) or by photos (virtual)
- Each Schools Lego Challenge overall winner will then compete against other schools overall winners at Brixhibition.
- All Lego Challenge overall winners will be judged by Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. members, to determine the Grand prize Winners by bringing their model to Hobart City Hall to be on display at the Brixhibition Hobart 2022 event Sat 8th & Sun 9th October 2022
- Grand Prize winners will be announced at 3:20pm on Sunday 9th October during Brixhibition Hobart 2022
